Mick Kraut caught the largest mangrove jack (48cm) which was the targeted species for January. In the Men's Estuary Competition Darryl Neill came first with 889 points and Troy Kirkwood came second with 825 points.

The Women's Competition Liz Kirk-wood came first with 640 points and Liza Cook second with 446 points. These women brought home some whopper grunter for their dinner. In the Junior Competition Declan Taylor received 342 points for his spotted grunter, queenfish and cod and Jayden Stewart came second with 90 points for his barred grunter. There were 4 anglers in the Minor

Juniors who also brought some prized fish to their tables. Benjamin Bryden received 562 points and Harrison McCloskey 407 points.


