Well it was a wet weekend and many anglers were keen to wet more than just a few lines for our first Estuary competition for 2019. An amazing 22 anglers fished who presented 11 crabs and 67 fish. It is fantastic to see a lineup of new competitors to add some excitement to our presentation. We are joined by some emerging junior anglers which we encourage for the future of our club.

The eleven crabs weighed a total of 11.48 kilograms. The largest weighing 1.20 (first - Darryl Neill) and 1.19 (second - Declan Taylor). Of the 67 fish the following were presented: Whiting 16, Bream 16, Trevally 7, Mangrove Jack 10, Cod 7, Fingermark 1, Sand Flathead 1, Spotted Grunter 2, Barred Grunter 6 and Salmon 1. Congratulations to Scott Pratt and Steven Woodford who both caught a 47 cm Mangrove Jack, our targeted species for this month.
